

CATTERLEN PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES # 64 page I.

A Meeting of the above Council took place on Friday 20th April 2018. in the Village Hall. Newton Reigny. At 7.30 p.m.

MATTERS ARISING. The clerk reported that a new lighting column had now been installed at an agreed location next to the Ginney, Catterlen. It was also noted that Signing of the agreement documents for a Parish Council wishing to take over the costs of street lighting from E.D.C ., had been postponed until the end of May 2018.

A planning application in the name of Mr Robson, for Four Dwellings on land at Bank Foot Newton Reigny, had recently been approved by Eden District Council, ref: 17/1095. In spite of strong and valid objections, being submitted, from local residents, and the Catterlen Parish Council. The case officer of Eden District Council, Planning Department, had also recommended refusal.

E.D.C. Councillor. Mrs. E. Martin was asked to explain how a decision to approve this application was allowed to happen. In the light of the unsatisfactory answers being given. The Vice Chairman tendered his resignation and immediately left the Meeting.
