

CATTERLEN PARISH COUNCIL # 66

A Meeting of the above Council took place on Tuesday 11th September 2018 at 7.30 p.m. in the Village Hall. Newton Reigny.

PRESENT. Councillors. C. J. Davies (chairman). J. Elliott. D. Savage. D. Bell. E.D.C. Councillor. Mrs L. Grisdale. and the clerk F. P. Barbour.

APOLOGIES. Were received from E.D.C. Cllr. Mrs. E. Martin. and Parish Cllrs. K. Monaghan. and A. Blackburn.

MINUTES of the last meeting were read, approved and signed by Chairman C. J. Davies.

MATTERS ARISING. Further to the agreed payments being made as noted in the #64 Minutes. The clerk reported payments of £2270. in respect of guaranteeing the price of the new Bus Shelter, and £195 . .52p in respect of the Parish Council's Annual Insurance Premium. Chairman C. J. Davies reported attending a recent general information Meeting held in Low Hesket Village Hall, arranged for the benefit of Parish Councillors. which he had found to be most informative.

CORRESPONDENCE. A request from Fellrunner Village Bus Ltd was received requesting a donation of £17. .10p . which was equal to usage by parishioners during the last year. It was agreed to complete a cheque in that sum. The clerk reported he was in communication with Anesco Solar Generation, with regard to payment of the Annual Community Grant. Clerk. Emails had been received stating the "matter" was at this time in the hands of their Finance Manager.

CASUAL VACANCY. In the light of two candidates wishing to be considered to fill the vacancy. The Parish Council asked the clerk to seek further information from them, in order to be able appoint the most suitable candidate.

STREET LIGHTING. The clerk presented documentation regarding the proposed Devolution of Street Lights in Catterlen and Newton Reigny villages, which will transfer full ownership to Catterlen Parish Council. This also will apply to the Newton Reigny Play Area. Following a lengthy discussion regarding all aspects of this matter. It was formally agreed to sign the Legal Agreement Documents on, or before 30th September 2018. Subject to clarification of a number of detail questions, and assurances being agreed, by the Eden District. Council's. Contracts Manager. Mr. N. Buck.

BUS SHELTER. It is understood that security fencing is now in hand. Therefore works are expected be able to commence soon.

CHURCH YARD MAINTENANCE. The clerk reported receiving good comments regarding the quality of maintenance carried out by Mr I. Moor during the grass cutting season. It is expected an invoice for the work will shortly be received.
