MATTERS ARISING. Casual Vacancy. Information has been received that the Council can legally operate with less than seven Members, providing there is a quorum. It was therefore agreed to continue with six Councillors for the time being.

CORRESPONDENCE. A letter from the Trustees Chairperson of The Nichol's Memorial Hall, Newton Reigny, requesting, continued, grant aid.

It was agreed to complete a cheque in the sum of £750.

ACCOUNTS. The completed Annual Internal Audit Report was presented, agreed, and signed by the Chairman and clerk, for publication on the Parish Council Website.

HIGHWAYS. The issue of vehicles parking at Catterlen junction to B 5305 is currently in the hands of C.C.C. Traffic Management Team. It is expected that this matter will be soon resolved.

STREET LIGHTS. It is reported that most new Street Lighting Columns are now in full operation, however the spread of illumination is now seen to be greatly reduced.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS. It was reported that the 30 mph indicator sign in Newton Reigny is continuing to malfunction. Church yard grass cutting Contractor appears to be having difficulty with this year's heavy growth. Report of a wasp nest in the Play Area. The clerk agreed to attend to these matters. There being no other business to transact. The Chairman closed the Meeting at 9.50 p.m.
