

# CATTERLEN PARISH COUNCIL. MINUTES # 71

A Meeting of the above Council took place on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> September at 7.30 p.m. in the Village Hall. Newton Reigny.

MINUTES. The Minutes of the last Meeting were read, approved and signed by C. J. Davies ( chairman)

MATTERS ARISING. Churchyard grass cutting, The clerk reported a meeting with Contractor Mr. Moor., who assured him that he was managing in spite of a rapid growth season.

CORRESPONDENCE. A request from Fellrunner Village Bus Ltd. For a donation towards running costs. It was agreed to complete a cheque in the sum of £30. Notice of date. 25/09/19 for C.A.L.C. A.G.M , and a copy of their latest Newsletter, was received. An invoice with regard to repair of the broken Newton Reigny, fingerpost for Penrith, was received. Payment was approved in the sum of £72 . .05.

PLANNING. An application No. 19/595. for construction of three dwellings on land at the rear of Blencathra Barn, was examined. It was agreed that there was no essential need, and if approved would have an unacceptable impact on the amenity values of neighbouring residents. Potential issues regarding a shared access in view of perceived inaccurate drawings as submitted. it was agreed to hold a Site Viewing next day at 10 am. Also to recommend E.D.C Planning Committee. arrange a site visit.

HIGHWAYS. It was reported posts were now installed at the Catterlen- B595 junction to deter parking. Further works are required, with regard to a complete solution, this is currently ongoing. It was also reported undulations on the road close to the north side of Newton Reigny bridge. Also large Pot Holes in the road out side Kiln Tofts.

EDEN COUNCIL REPORT. Councillor, Mr David Ryland reported the production of the New Councils "Vision for Eden District 2019–2033., he then extended an invitation Members of the Parish Council to attend a Presentation to be held at the Reghed Centre, on 1<sup>st</sup> October 6pm for 7pm.
