

CATTERLEN PARISH COUNCIL. MINUTES. # 72.

A meeting of the above Council took place on Tuesday 29th October 2019. At 7.30 p.m. in the Village Hall. Newton Reigny.

PRESENT. Councillor's. C. J. Davies. (chairman). K. Monaghan. D. Bell. D. Savage. E.D.C. Councillor. Mrs. E. Martin. and the clerk F. P. Barbour.

APOLOGIES. Were received from Councillors. J. Elliott. A. Blackburn. and E.D.C. Councillor. Mr. D. Ryland.

MINUTES. The minutes of the last Meeting were read agreed, and signed by Chairman. C. J. Davies.

MATTERS ARISING. Churchyard grass cutting. The Contractor has assured the clerk, End of Season work will be completed. It was reported Newton Reigny Village Sign Post, will be completely refurbished and moved back on the footway, to be safe from further vehicular damage. Cllr C. J. Davies reported on attending E.D.C. presentation at Reghed. 01/10/19. comment, "Street Lighting improvements will in future take place in Urban Areas, only."

CORRESPONDENCE. A request from Great North Air Ambulance Service, for Grant Aid. It was agreed to complete a cheque in the sum of £100. A letter of thanks from the Fellrunner Bus Co. was received. Notice of C.A.L.C. A.G.M. on date 09/11/19 was received.

PLANNING MATTERS. Applications 19/0740. & 19/0741. in respect of Agricultural Development, at Catterlen Hall. For Messrs. Dent, were examined. There were No Objections. With regard to material changes to the formally approved application No. 19/0371. Proposed changes, with particular reference to amended, foul drainage treatment, and disposal, were discussed, and noted.

HIGHWAYS. With regard to the continued parking of Work Vans, at location Catterlen Junction with B 595. Complaints are being received regarding this hazard. It is noted that a School Bus currently picks up and sets down children at this location. It was agreed that the removal of all Vehicle Parking at this location is of the highest priority. The clerk was instructed to contact Cumbria Highways, accordingly. It was also noted. The undulating road surface at Newton River Bridge, and potholes that have previously been reported, are not to date, repaired.

EDEN DISTRICT COUNCILLOR REPORT. Councillor. Mrs E. Martin reported. The new E.D.C. Plan for the next four year period was being submitted to Executive and would in due time be presented to The Full Council. It is expected to be a "Green Plan".

ANY OTHER BUSINESS. It was reported that all the new Street Lighting columns in the Parish, were now in place. However it was agreed that the general level of footway illumination, is now less. Any remaining original lighting units still in use are expected to remain until year 2022. There being no other business to transact the Chairman closed the Meeting at 8.30 p.m.
