MATTERS ARISING. All matters can be transacted in the Agenda as appropriate.

CORRESPONDENCE Notice of the upcoming CALC. A G M. was received. A letter from a Catterlen resident regarding the Jubilee Bench. It was agreed to research a replacement, and to consider relocation. Item the on a future Agenda. Invitation from G. N. Air Ambulance for grant aid. It was agreed to complete a cheque in the sum of £250. A request for grant aid from The Fellrunner Village Bus Ltd. It was agreed to submit £20. to cover calculated Parishioner usage. Mr W. Leech has officially tendered his resignation regarding Parish Council Website and I. T maintenance. Miss Alice Taylor of Sunset House has been dealing with any I.T problems since June 2021 it was agreed to offer her the contract for Website maintenance and I.T issues. The clerk reported the Parish Council computer, and printer were substandard and out dated. It was agreed the clerk research suitable and appropriate replacements, and costs.

PLANNING MATTERS. An application for reserved matters, regarding Plot 4. Joiner's Brow. Catterlen was considered. There were no objections. An Application ref;- 21/0840 for the creation of Terraces in front of Balmacwyn House. Newton Reigny., was examined. It was noted that the application was without regard to the existing Heritage Village Water Troughs. In view of the possibility of the loss of these Ancient Village Features. It was agreed to informally consult with the applicants, and to formally object to the current Planning Application, with a recommendation for submission of a revised plan. Showing the Troughs and Public Access, being preserved.

HIGHWAYS. The clerk reported confirmation from C. C. Highways, regarding finger post, maintenance at the junction of Laithes.---Catterlen road., is now included in their programme, for repair. With regard to P. Council request for creation of a 40 M.P.H. speed restriction to be created on the B 5305 from the Wood Head Farm junction towards M6 junction 40. According to the information received to date, the matter is still under consideration.

It was reported that there were two planning enforcements in place from E.D.C with regard to unapproved construction, or development. within the Parish. There being no other business to transact the Chairman closed the Meeting at 8.30 p.m.
