MINUTES. The Minutes of the last Meeting having been circulated were approved.

MATTERS ARISING. Wit regard to the Parish Council Computer Hardware upgrade replacement the clerk presented spec. and prices for consideration. No action at this time. Public bench issues it was agreed to repair the original metal /timber bench to be reinstated on its original location, and to purchase two new plastic recycled benches to mark the forthcoming Queen E.R. 2nd Platinum Jubilee.

CORRESPONDENCE A request was received from Newton Reigny P. C.C with regard to assisting with expected cost of extensive tree maintenance works, it was agreed to arrange grant aid of £500. Letters of appreciation were received from the Fellrunner Bus Company, and The Great North Air Ambulance Service. In respect of donations received from Parish Council. The clerk presented a short update on the planned progress in creating the proposed new County Unitary Changes. Expected to be fully in place by 2028, at an estimated cost of £15---£18 Million.

PLANNING MATTERS. An application No. 21/1042 in the name of Mr I Dalton for the removal of condition S 106 with reference to the development at Joiners Brow —Park View. Catterlen. Was considered. It was agreed to recommend the condition should remain. An application No. 21/0996 in the name of Mr. D. Bell . For a dwelling on Plot 5. Joiners Close---Park View was examined there were no objections. It was noted that approval had been given to planning application No. 21/0840.

HIGHWAYS. The clerk reported no progress in the matter of creation of a Speed Restriction on the B 5305 at the East Catterlen Junction. It was agreed to seek the advise and support of Cumbria Constabulary. With regard to this matter.
