

CATTERLEN PARISH COUNCIL. MINUTES # 82

A Meeting of the above Parish Council took place on Wednesday 29th March 2023. at 7.30 p.m. in the Village Hall. Newton Reigny.

PRESENT. Councillors. C. J. Davies (chairman). A. Blackburn. K. Monaghan. J . Elliott. D. Bell. and the clerk F. P. Barbour.

APOLOGIES. were received from Cllr. D. Savage.

THE MINUTES. were read agreed and signed by Chairman C. J . Davies.

MATTERS ARISING. It was agreed to order a pack of 36 King Charles 111. Coronation Mugs, for presentation to Parish Children. at a Parish Party to be held on On 6th May. Payment was approved in the sum of £ 295 . .20p. Other matters can be transacted under items of the agenda.

CORRESPONDENCE. A request from the Trustee Chair. of the Village Hall for grant aid to assist with annual running expenses. was received. It was agreed to Grant £750. to be submitted from next year budget. An invitation to renew annual CALC. Subscription was received.

ACCOUNTS The clerk presented and explained the Statement of Accounts for the year ended 31st March 2023. they were agreed, and passed for payment, and will now be submitted for Internal Audit by ASAP Accountancy Services Ltd. A request from The Village Hall, for grant aid towards their annual running costs. It was agreed to Grant £750. to be paid from the next year P. C. budget.

HIGHWAYS. It was reported that some pot holes in the Parish had been repaired, and the flooding problem at Sewborwens Corner had been addressed. The faulty Speed Indicator next to Newton Reigny Bus Shelter, was now work in progress.

A request to create a small area of hard standing next to the recently installed Bench Seat. Located North of Honey House. This would allow safe parking for wheelchairs, and child pram or push chairs. The clerk agreed to contact Highways with regard to this matter. A report was received with regard to vehicles in Catterlen Village regularly travelling above the 30 mph limit, causing distress to pedestrians walking where there is no footpath provided. The clerk agreed to contact Cumbria Police ASAP.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS. The clerk noted a possible Parish Council Election could take place in the event of more than 7 nomination papers being submitted. The date set for any Elections is 04/05/2023.

There being no other business to transact, the Chairman closed the Meeting at 8.55 p.m.
