"Existing parking problems will increase, due to current use of property as an Air/B&B. Overdevelopment in close proximity to adjacent dwellings. resulting in a loss of residential amenity value. Parish Council has received strong local objections regarding this application. Comments agreed by Parish Council therefore The Catterlen Parish Council following this site visit agreed that this application is not appropriate.
- 2. Application ref: 2025/1314/FPA For Installation of three covered padel courts, and external seating. On the Newton Rigg Campus. In the name of Leo Sawrij Ltd. It was agreed that there were no objections to this application.
- 3. Application ref:- 2025/1213/DISC For Hard and Soft landscaping works, at Reigny House Cottage. In the Name of Julian Stevens. There were no objections to this application.
