DEPARTED MERIT. One minute silence was observed in respect of the recent death of Vice Chairman. Councillor. John. R. Elliott.

MINUTES. of the last Meeting were agreed and signed by Chairman J. A. Blackburn.  
MATTERS ARISING. There were no Matters, which could not be transacted during the agenda.

CORRESPONDENCE. A quotation for grass cutting in the Churchyard, and Play Area, was received from W. Martindale, in the sum of £150. per cut, being same as previous season. It was agreed to accept this price. A letter was received regarding non collection of refuse, during the extended period of water supply works through Catterlen Village, with request for Parish Council support, it was agreed to contact W. & F. C. C with regard to this matter. Notice of 20 m.p.h. speed limit Initial Consultation Launch was received, Catterlen. P. C agreed no action at this time. Notice of the CALC annual subscription in the sum of £207 . 75 w as received, it was agreed to continue membership. Temporary Road Closure - U3444 at Hasty Bank, junction C1037, for 540 metres. Period of one month.-- 27/04/2026.

STREET LIGHT AGREEMENT. The clerk reported that the exact number of lights in the Parish, needed to be confirmed, and formally agreed.
