MATTERS ARISING. A quotation from “Jacs Gateways” was received, and considered to be excessive, it was agreed to seek prices from W. Relph Farm Supplies. Casual Vacancies, the clerk reported that a parishioner has wished to be considered, it was agreed that co-option can take place at the next C. P. C. Meeting. S.I.D Installation, a date for installation will be agreed. A.S.A.P.

CORRESPONDENCE. Notice was received with an offer to install a Park Bench in Catterlen Village., provided by United Utilities free of charge, as a gesture of goodwill following the recent, prolonged, and disruptive water main works which were carried out in the Village.

The Chairman and clerk met on site together with U .U. representative, to agree a suitable location. A request received from the Trustees of the Village Hall. for grant aid, it was agreed to complete a cheque in the sum of £850. as in the previous year. The clerk reported notice of a National Civil Servant salary increase of 3.3% back dated from 01/04/26. The Members had no objection with regard to this matter.

PLANNING. An application by Mr M.H. Elliott, for conversion of a Dutch Barn to form a new Dwelling at Espland House Farm, Newton Reigny was examined there were no objections.

HIGHWAYS. It was reported that Signage works had now commenced with regard to the planned. H.G.V. Length and Width restrictions, due to be enforced within Newton Reigny Village.
